Dialogue

Parent: Let's wash your face.

Parent: Let's wipe behind your ears.

【*Advanced Level*】

Dialogue

Parent: Time to wash your face.

Parent: Then do your cheeks and your chin.

Parent: Don't forget behind your ears.

Parent: And last—wipe your neck.

Parent: Great job!

Cleaning Up After Using a Wash Basin
